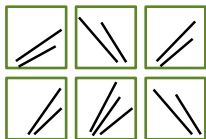

Romanian Handicapped Ministries

RHM was founded in 1998 by four members of Faith Church in the Black Sea city of Constanta, Romania. What began as a short-term opportunity has grown into a year round full-time program which operates at the RHM-Ro., our incorporated name in Romania. The Madison Center operates 11 months out of the year, taking a summer break in August and at Christmas time. RHM serves 24 formal foundation members and almost 70 persons including the family members of our young adult members, most of which suffer from profound disabilities. The work in Constanta is carried out by 3 full-time staff members and three part-time staff and administrative personnel. The daily program includes functional literacy training, language arts, math, social skills and activities, physical therapy/complete medical care and the provision of needed

medicines, weekly Bible Study, and opportunity to go into the public school with a program on the worth of the individual from a CHRISTIAN perspective, handicapped or not!
