

10 Critical Points of Biblical Evangelism

1. Know the Gospel

1 Pet. 3:15, "*... always being prepared to make a defense to anyone who asks you for a reason for the hope that is in you,*"

2. Speak the gospel

1 Cor 5:11, "*... since we know the fear of the Lord we persuade men.*"

3. Live the gospel (a life that commends the gospel)

Gal 2:14, "*... I saw that their conduct was not in line with the truth of the gospel,*"

4. Have confidence in the gospel.

Rm 1:16, "*For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes,*"

5. Don't assume the Gospel.

2 Tim 2:2, "*and what you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses entrust to faithful men who will be able to teach others also.*"

6. Understanding Gospel biblical conversion

Mk 1:15, “. . . *the time is fulfilled and the kingdom of God is at hand, repent and believe in the gospel.*”

7. Be Bold and Clear with the gospel

Eph 6:19, “*pray . . . also for me, that words may be given to me in opening my mouth boldly to proclaim the mystery of the gospel,*”

8. Gospel Love! (Loving communities)

John 13:34, “*By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another.*” John 17:20–21, “*I do not ask for these only, but also for those who will believe in me through their word, [21] that they may all be one, just as you, Father, are in me, and I in you, that they also may be in us, so that the world may believe that you have sent me.*”

9. The gospel as a spiritual discipline

Rm 10:1, “*Brothers, my heart’s desire and prayer to God for them is that they may be saved.*”

10. Evangelistic leadership

Acts 20:20–21, “. . . *how I did not shrink from declaring to you anything that was profitable, and teaching you in public and from house to house, [21] testifying both to Jews and to Greeks of repentance toward God and of faith in our Lord Jesus Christ.*”
