**Due to recent updates from these organizations, masks will no longer be required inside our building - effective immediately.** CDC recommends that those who have not been vaccinated should wear a mask. If you feel more comfortable wearing a mask, we welcome you to do so.

- Overflow sections will remain spaced out for those who would prefer that.

- We will continue to take the Lord's Supper in our current manner for the near future, with the hopes of re-introducing our former way of doing it (coming forward and being served) down the road.
