Passing of the Peace

One of the most important effects of the Gospel is not only our unity with God, but our unity with one another (Ephesians 2:14-22; Galatians 3:28-29). Thus, each Sunday we are reminded that Christ not only saved us as individuals, he also made us a family (Romans 8:16-17). The peace we have vertically with God overflows into horizontal peace with one another (Luke 2:14). It is actually an important aspect of our worship that we take time each week to welcome one another just as God in Christ has welcomed us (Romans 15:7). We do this by exchanging warm greetings to one another in the Lord, perhaps accompanied by handshakes, hugs, or fist-bumps!

MISSIONARY SPOTLIGHT

Heart to Heart | Eurasia | Afghanistan for Jesus:

All things are possible with Jesus. Heart to Heart had a strategy to reach Afghanistan through the neighboring country of Tajikistan. For the past 4-5 years, Evangelism Explosion leaders from Tajikistan went back to Afghanistan making contact with some home churches there. Eight Afghans were trained during this time. They returned home and started the ministry in northern Afghanistan, and planted three new home churches. There were plans to move into southern Afghanistan, then the Taliban took over. This became a very intense situation for these brothers and sisters since they're well known in that northern town. They escaped to Kabul the very night the town was taken. These brothers and sisters have a strong faith to witness for Jesus. Keep these eight missionaries in your prayers. Pray in faith that many will come to Jesus.
