## Call to Worship: Isaiah 43:1-7

1 Now this is what the LORD says—  
the one who created you, Jacob,  
and the one who formed you, Israel—  
**"Do not fear, for I have redeemed you;**  
**I have called you by your name; you are mine.**

**2 When you pass through the waters,**

**I will be with you,**  
**and the rivers will not overwhelm you.**

**When you walk through the fire,**

**you will not be scorched,**  
**and the flame will not burn you.**

3 For I am the LORD your God,  
the Holy One of Israel, and your Savior.  
I have given Egypt as a ransom for you,  
Cush and Seba in your place.

4 Because you are precious in my sight

and nations instead of your life.

<sup>31</sup>What then shall we say to these things? It is God who justifies. <sup>34</sup>Who is to condemn? Christ Jesus is the one who died – more than that, who was raised – who is at the right hand of God, who indeed is interceding for us. <sup>35</sup>Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or danger, or sword?


## Congregational Meeting
