

WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

Fruit from the Preaching of God's Word: Pray that God's Word, as it's preached each week, will do its work of rebuking, correcting, and training in righteousness so that we would be "made complete, equipped for every good work" (2 Tim. 3:16-17). Pray for our pastors, as they labor each week, to preach faithfully, clearly, with great patience, in Christ-exalting ways, and in accordance with sound doctrine (2 Tim. 4:1-3).

Austin and Morgan Sides with On Goal Soccer: Pray for the Sides, members of Faith Church, as they adjust to being a new family of five (Phil. 4:19), with the birth of Declan David Sides, born in October (Ps. 127:3). Pray for them as they begin recruiting godly coaches (Exod. 18:21) and planning summer evangelistic camps (1 Pet. 3:15). Pray for lasting, spiritual fruit to come from their spring and summer efforts (Acts 12:24).

Our Deacons: Pray for the 15 men and women who faithfully serve as our deacons at Faith Church. Pray that the pastor in "CAR" will continue to be a faithful shepherd (1 Pet. 5:1-5). He recently passed out some scriptural literature and showed the Jesus Film to a group of Fulani. Pray for the Cones, as they support these ministry efforts and continue their translation work of the Banda-Linda New Testament for the Fulani (2 Tim. 1:13-14; 2:1-2).

Our Finances: Pray that God would meet our financial needs (Philippians 4:19), so we can continue to do faithful gospel work in Cincinnati and beyond.

Responsive Readings

During service each week we have moments with responsive readings of Scripture and/or prayers together. Just like singing, we find that this is a way for the entire congregation to be fully engaged in participation and ministry to one another. We believe this is the joyful duty of all Christians and not simply the pastors who lead worship and preach (Hebrews 10:23-25). As we sing, read, and pray out loud together we are cementing truth in our own hearts as well as those around us. These responsive readings could come from Scripture passages, something written by one of the pastors, or other resources such as *The Worship Sourcebook* or *The Valley of Vision*.
