WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

Hope for the Discouraged: Pray for those who are hurting, discouraged, depressed, lonely, and hopeless within our church family. Pray that they would know God's love for them (Eph. 3:14-19). Pray that they would sense the nearness of God (Ps. 34:18). Pray that they would put their hope and confidence in Christ alone (1 Pet. 1:3-6). Pray that our church would wrap our arms around them (Rom. 12:10-15).

Karen Norton with Athletes in Action: Pray for Karen as she travels to Tirana, Albania in March to use sports as a tool to build relationships with college students and share the gospel (1 Thess. 2:8). She will have the chance to speak in a few college classes as well. Pray for soft hearts and miraculous conversions (Jn. 3:5-8). Pray also for unity and encouragement between the American and Albanian teams as they work together (Jn. 17:20-23).

Our Women's Bible Studies: Please pray for spiritual fruit for the Women's Bible Studies that have recently started. Pray that those leading these studies – Jennifer French, Karen Hitchcock, Mary Norton, Rosemary Braxton, Karen Palmer, Debbi Allan, Laura Kingsley, and Sandy Deel – would be equipped to teach and train effectively (2 Tim. 3:16-17). Pray that each woman participating would grow in their knowledge of the Bible, affection for Jesus, and love for others (2 Pet. 1:3-11).

Our Governing Authorities: Pray for our current governing authorities, like Governor DeWine, President Biden, and others (1 Tim. 2:1-4). Pray that they would lead with character, wisdom, and care for all. Pray for effective governmental leadership, "so that we may lead a tranquil and quiet life in all godliness and dignity."

Our Finances: Pray that God would meet our financial needs (Philippians 4:19), so we can continue to do faithful gospel work in Cincinnati and beyond.

WHY DO WE DO THAT?

Benediction

We conclude our services each week with a benediction, which is a blessing for the road. The word "benediction" comes from the Latin for "a good word". One of our pastors or leaders will dismiss us with such a blessing, reminding us that the same God who gathers us also sends us out with his blessing, as his people, on mission to make more and better disciples. We see various benedictions in Scripture (Numbers 6:24-26; 2 Cor. 13:14; Hebrews 13:20-21; etc), and often use one of these or come up with our own. We raise our hands during the benediction as a sign of our unity with one another and receptiveness towards God's blessing.
