WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

Trip to the UAE and Kuwait: Godwin Sathianathan, Drew French, and David French are leaving Tuesday the 7th for a trip to Dubai and Kuwait. In partnership with our missionary Nissin Matthews, they will be speaking at a student ministry conference in Dubai to students from all around the world. They will also preach and teach in various churches, including joining Blaine Boyd at his church plant in Kuwait and preaching there as well. Pray for good fruit from the Word work, and good encouragement for the laborers there (3 John 1:5-8).

Regular Ministry of the Word: Pray that the Lord would use the Word ministered in our church to bring about lasting spiritual fruit (Luke 6:43-45). May those who have not been regenerated become Christians (Acts 13:48-49). And may those who are God's children grow in their battle with sin and become more like Jesus (Romans 12:2).

Unity in Diversity: Pray for our church to continue on in a spirit of love and unity (Romans 12:3-8). May we grow in diversity across many different cultural dividing lines. Pray that the unifying power of the gospel would be the thing that binds us together. (John 17:20-26).

Community Groups: Pray for our Community Groups as we gather together in homes for fellowship, sermon application, and prayer. Ask the Lord to help us obey the various commands God gives us for how we are to treat one another (Romans 12:10-18). May these gatherings foster meaningful Christian friendships that spur us on to more maturity in Christ. Pray that those leading these groups will be encouraged and strengthened in their work.

Deacon Ministry & Benevolence Team: Pray for our active Deacon Ministry here at Faith Church, led by Scott Ruotolo. Pray for the 15 men and women who faithfully serve our congregation (Acts 6:1-7). Pray specifically for our Benevolence Team who help families with emergency financial needs. We have a table out in the lobby for you to learn more about the Benevolence Team.
