WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

Pastor Godwin and Pastor Drew and Dave French: They are on a mission trip to United Arab Emirates for ten days. Pray that they will have travel mercies and safety on their trip. Pray they are able to have a fruitful ministry to those they visit and for their preaching and teaching opportunities (Col. 1:6). Pray for their families as well.

Deacon Team: Pray for the deacons who serve in countless ways for our church family (Acts 6:3; 1 Tim. 3:13). They are active in visiting the sick, meeting financial needs through the Benevolence fund, and addressing needs that arise from emergencies, unusual pressures, and stress. They seek to make contact with those who are infrequent in church attendance and to regularly pray for all those with specific prayer needs. If you know of a specific need in the church family, feel free to contact one of the deacons listed on the church website.

Intimate Marriage Workshop: Pray for IMW as it comes to the final week of the semester (3/18/23). Pray for the marriages of the couples who have participated, that they would continue to maintain the progress they have made over the last 5 weeks of the workshop. Pray also for couples who are struggling in their marriages, that they would seek the help they need in strengthening their marriages.

Upcoming Congregational Meeting (3/26/23): Pray that God would meet our financial needs (Phil. 4:19), as we come to the end of the fiscal year. Pray for the election of church officers (1 Tim. 3:1-13) that morning and for the meeting that will take place that evening, that it will all glorify the Lord and strengthen the unity of our church (Eph. 4:3-6).

Community Groups: Pray for the many Community Groups that are vital to helping us grow in deeper communion with God, community with one another, and on mission to make disciples. Pray for the CG leaders. Pray that these groups not only grow deeper in these ways, but they would multiply as well (Acts 2:42, 47).

WHY DO WE DO THAT?

Expository Preaching

The key word in “expository” is *expose*. In expository sermons, the main point of the sermon should *expose* the main point of the chosen text. For each text, our preachers consider the structure, literary context, historical setting, etc. Most importantly, we recognize that the entire Bible is ultimately about the person & work of Jesus Christ (Luke 24:44-49). As we work through Bible books, we trust that God’s sheep will be fed a well-balanced diet & the church will be slowly molded into Christ’s radiant bride (2 Cor 11:2; Eph 5:22-33). While our regular diet of preaching will work through books, we will occasionally do a topical series to address something the Elders believe is important (2 Tim 4:1-5).
