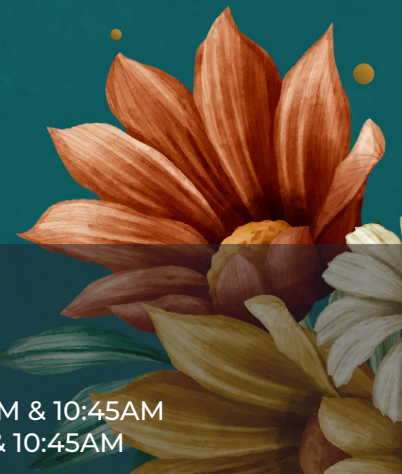

## WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

**Conversions During this Easter Season:** Pray by name for unbelievers in your life. Pray for God to miraculously regenerate particular unbelievers in our midst this Easter season, as we welcome them to church or in our homes (Jn. 3:1-15). Pray that our unbelieving friends, neighbors, co-workers, and loved ones would hear the gospel and receive it with faith and repentance (Mk. 1:14-15). Pray that Faith Church folks would be bold in their evangelism and intentional in their invitations to church (Col. 4:2-6).

**Barrett & Dayna Brown with Cru:** Barrett recently shared a video of Cru students in New Zealand handing out cups to NZ college students. The giveaway allowed Cru students called several hundred students to make appointments to share their faith using a Cru magazine handout. This tool is used for outreach in many Cru ministries all over the world. The Browns were sent to Abbotsford, British Columbia to attend the dedication of the new Power to Change (P2C) National Resource Center (P2C is the Cru for Canada). His team helped them rethink their office space design. Barrett just completed a similar project, so he had great experience to share.

**Our Women's Bible Studies:** Please pray for spiritual fruit for the Women's Bible Studies that are in session. Pray that those leading these studies – Jennifer French, Karen Hitchcock, Mary Norton, Rosemary Braxton, Karen Palmer, Debbi Allan, Laura Kingsley, and Sandy Deel – would be equipped to teach and train effectively (2 Tim. 3:16-17). Pray that each woman participating would grow in their knowledge of the Bible, affection for Jesus, and love for others (2 Pet. 1:3-11).

**Our Governing Authorities:** Pray for our current governing authorities, like Milford's mayor, Lisa Evans, and Ohio's governor, Mike DeWine. Pray they would lead with character, integrity, wisdom, and care for all. Pray for effective leadership so that we may lead a tranquil and quiet life in all godliness and dignity (2 Tim. 2:1-4).

**Unity in Diversity:** Pray for our church to continue on in a spirit of love and unity (Romans 12:3-8). Pray that the unifying power of the gospel would be the thing that binds us together. (John 17:20-26).

## WHY DO WE DO THAT?

### Expository Preaching

The key word in "expository" is expose. In expository sermons, the main point of the sermon should expose the main point of the chosen text. For each text, our preachers consider the structure, literary context, historical setting, etc. Most importantly, we recognize that the entire Bible is ultimately about the person & work of Jesus Christ (Luke 24:44-49). As we work through Bible books, we trust that God's sheep will be fed a well-balanced diet & the church will be slowly molded into Christ's radiant bride (2 Cor 11:2; Eph 5:22-33). While our regular diet of preaching will work through books, we will occasionally do a topical series to address something the Elders believe is important (2 Tim 4:1-5).
