WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

Hope for the Discouraged: Pray for those who are hurting, discouraged, depressed, lonely, and hopeless within our church family. Pray that they would know God's love for them (Eph. 3:14-19). Pray that they would sense the nearness of God (Ps. 34:18). Pray that they would put their hope and confidence in Christ alone (1 Pet. 1:3-6). Pray that our church would wrap our arms around them (Rom. 12:10-15).

Our Staff: Pray for the 10 faithful men and women who serve on staff at Faith Church. Thank God for their gospel partnership and willingness to lead, serve behind-the-scenes to support our church, minister God's Word, and shepherd the flock (Phil. 1:3-5). Pray for their families and their children in particular to be converted (Rom. 10:9-10) or to grow in their knowledge and affection for Jesus.

Austin and Morgan Sides with On Goal Soccer: Pray for the Sides, members of Faith Church, as they adjust to being a new family of five (Phil. 4:19), with the birth of Declan David sides, born in October (Ps. 127:3). Pray for them as they begin recruiting godly coaches (Exod. 18:21) and planning summer evangelistic camps (1 Pet. 3:15). Pray for lasting, spiritual fruit to come from their spring and summer efforts (Acts 12:24).

Those Struggling with Addictions: Pray for those in our midst who are struggling with addictions. Pray that they would bring their struggles and frustrations to Jesus (Matt. 11:28-30). Pray they would repent of their sins and seek forgiveness (Mk. 1:14-15). Pray they would find practical wisdom (Prov. 3:21-23) and supportive friends in our church family (1 Thess. 5:11) that can help them live a stable, addictions-free, God-pleasing life (Phil. 2:12-16).

Our Community Groups: Pray that our CGs would continue to be places where true biblical community is practiced & preserved. Pray for individuals within CGs to eagerly practice the "one-anothers" of the New Testament – such as, love one another (Jn. 13:34), honor one another (Rom. 12:10), build up one another (Rom. 14:19), admonish one another (Rom. 15:14), serve one another (Gal. 5:13), bear one another's burdens (Gal. 6:2), and forgive one another (Eph. 4:2, 32).

The mission of Faith Church is to make more and better disciples here and around the world.

Weekly Lord's Summer

The Lord's Supper (or Communion) is a tradition given to the church by Jesus Christ which calls us to remember his death on the cross for us. It is a unique and beautiful way of preaching the Gospel as the broken bread represents his broken body, and the cup represents his shed blood. We observe this meal together as a church each week because we believe the clearest testimony of Scripture is that this was something done every time the church gathered. We do this in response to the preaching of God's Word, being spiritually nourished by the Lord and reminded of our unity in the Gospel. All who have trusted in Christ for salvation are welcome to join us by coming forward to partake while we sing. (Luke 22:7-23; 1 Cor. 11:17-34)

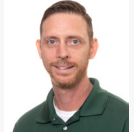
