WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

Our Community Groups: Pray that our CGs would continue to be places where true biblical community is practiced & preserved. Pray for individuals within CGs to eagerly practice the "one-anothers" of the New Testament – such as, love one another (Jn. 13:34), honor one another (Rom. 12:10), build up one another (Rom. 14:19), admonish one another (Rom. 15:14), serve one another (Gal. 5:13), bear one another's burdens (Gal. 6:2), and forgive one another (Eph. 4:2, 32).

Mark and Leslie Wannemacher: Prav that Mark and Leslie will continue to make disciples among the difficult to reach people they are working among in Asia (Acts 2:42-47). Praise God that there has been enough peace amidst the coup for Mark to cross the border and work with churches there.

Fruit from the Preaching of God's Word: Pray that God's Word, as it's preached each week, will do its work of rebuking, correcting, and training in righteousness so that we would be "made complete, equipped for every good work" (2 Tim. 3:16-17). Pray for our pastors, as they labor each week, to preach faithfully, clearly, with great patience, in Christ-exalting ways. and in accordance with sound doctrine (2 Tim. 4:1-3).

Our Deacons: Pray for the 15 men and women who faithfully serve as our deacons at Faith Church. Pray for their ministry of service to our church family, as they visit the sick, distribute from the benevolence fund, pray for our people, provide for tangible needs, etc. (Acts 6:1-7). Pray also for Scott Ruotolo as he leads the team

Our Humility and Love: Pray we would do nothing out of selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility consider others as more important than ourselves (Phil. 2:3). Pray we would look out not only for our own interests, but also for the interests of others (Phil. 2:4). Pray we would adopt the same attitude of Christ, who humbled himself for our sake (Phil. 2:5-11).

Our Finances: Pray that God would meet our financial needs (Philippians 4:19), so we can continue to do faithful gospel work in Cincinnati and beyond.

The mission of Faith Church is to make more and better disciples here and around the world.

Benediction

We conclude our service each week with a benediction, which is a blessing for the road. The word "benediction" comes from the Latin for "a good word". One of our pastors or leaders will dismiss us with such a blessing, reminding us that the same God who gathers us also sends us out with his blessing, as his people, on mission to make more and better disciples. We see various benedictions in Scripture (Numbers 6:24-26; 2 Corinthians 13:14; Hebrews 13:20-21; etc), and often use one of these or come up with our own. We raise our hands during the benediction as a sign of our unity with one another and receptiveness towards God's blessing.
