WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

The Unborn: As the Lord has given humanity a special place in his creation (Psalm 8) we know that human life is sacred. Ask the Lord to protect the lives of those not yet born (Psalm 139:13). Ask the Lord to help our state rule with justice that protects innocent life (Romans 13:1-7). Pray for mothers who may be considering an abortion to find great hope in the gospel of Jesus and practical help from Christians (1 John 3:17). Pray for the ministry of LifeForward to be effective in this work.

Nisin and Joanna Mathew: Pray for Nisin as he leads FOCUS ministries reaching college students in the UAE with the gospel (John 3:16). As there are students from many countries closed to the gospel, or where there is minimal gospel witness, pray that God would use the ministry of FOCUS to reach the nations (Matthew 28:19). Pray that the FOCUS team would be encouraged in their ministry and bold with the gospel (1 Corinthians 2:2).

Hope for the Discouraged: Pray for those who are hurting. discouraged, depressed, lonely, and hopeless within our church family. Pray that they would know God's love for them (Eph. 3:14-19). Pray that they would sense the nearness of God (Ps. 34:18). Pray that they would put their hope and confidence in Christ alone (1 Pet. 1:3-6). Pray that our church would wrap our arms around them (Rom. 12:10-15).

Conversions: Pray by name for unbelievers in your life. Pray for God to miraculously regenerate particular unbelievers who are connected to our members, as we welcome them to church or in our homes (Jn. 3:1-15). Pray that our unbelieving friends, neighbors, co-workers, and loved ones would hear the gospel and receive it with faith and repentance (Mark 1:14-15). Pray that Faith Church folks would be bold in their evangelism and intentional in their invitations to church (Acts 4:23-31).

Unity in Diversity: Pray for our church to continue on in a spirit of love and unity (Romans 12:3-8). May we grow in diversity across many different cultural dividing lines. Pray that the unifying power of the gospel would be the thing that binds us together. (John 17:20-26).

The mission of Faith Church is to make more and better disciples here and around the world.

WHY DO WE DO THAT?

Passing the Peace

One of the most important effects of the Gospel is not only our unity with God, but our unity with one another (Eph. 2:14-22; Gal. 3:28-29). Thus, each Sunday we are reminded that Christ not only saved us as individuals, he also made us a family (Romans 8:16-17). The peace we have vertically with God overflows into horizontal peace with one another (Luke 2:14). It is actually an important aspect of our worship that we take time each week to welcome one another just as God in Christ has welcomed us (Romans 15:7). We do this by exchanging warm greetings to one another in the Lord, perhaps accompanied by handshakes, hugs, or fist-bumps!
