


# Congregational Meeting June 14 // 7pm // Sanctuary



### **WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:**

Christian Faithfulness: Pray for Christians who face unique pressures during the month of June because of PRIDE month. As they face pressures to condone sin, pray that they would have faithfulness and wisdom (Is. 5:20). As they face opportunities to show love and kindness to those who do not believe the gospel, pray for winsome evangelism (1 Cor. 5:20). As they have to navigate ethically challenging situations, pray the Lord would give them wisdom to retain a clear conscience (Acts 24:16). Pray that everything we do and say this month would be born out of a love for God and for our neighbor (Mark 12:29-31).

Fruit from Jamie Phillips' Memorial Service: Many non-Christians came to honor Jamie and her family last weekend where they heard the Gospel clearly. Pray the Lord would graciously draw them out of darkness and into his marvelous light (1 Peter 2:9). Ask the Lord to bring about conversion as a result of Jamie's faithful testimony (Heb. 12:1).

<u>Our Homebound Members:</u> There are more than a dozen individuals who wish they could join us on Sunday mornings but are unable to do so due to health concerns. Please pray for their spiritual and emotional health and strength in the midst of their difficult challenges. Pray for their ability to be comforted by God's presence in the midst of their loneliness and isolation. Pray for our church members and our deacons to find ways to connect with them and encourage them.

<u>Our Elders:</u> Pray they would watch their life and doctrine closely, and that they would do nothing to disqualify them from their service (1 Tim. 3:1-7; 4:16). Pray they would shepherd the flock of Faith Church not out of compulsion, but willingly; not for shameful gain, but eagerly; not domineering over those in their charge, but being examples to the flock (1 Peter 5:2-3).

Karen Zando with CRU-AIA: Karen flew to the Middle East on June 4th to facilitate two workshops for Athletes in Action leadership and local co-workers. Pray that the Lord will use these workshops to help advance their work in this part of the world. Karen's luggage did not land with her. Pray that the trip back home is a smooth one.

### WHY DO WE DO THAT?

### **Expository Preaching**

The key word in "expository" is expose. In expository sermons, the main point of the sermon should expose the main point of the chosen text. For each text, our preachers consider the structure, literary context, historical setting, etc. Most importantly, we recognize that the entire Bible is ultimately about the person & work of Jesus Christ (Luke 24:44-49). As we work through Bible books, we trust that God's sheep will be fed a well-balanced diet & the church will be slowly molded into Christ's radiant bride (2 Cor. 11:2; Eph. 5:22-33). While our regular diet of preaching will work through books, we will occasionally do a topical series to address something the Elders believe is important (2 Tim. 4:1-5).
