





WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

<u>Our Sanctification:</u> As we face trials of various kinds, pray that you would remain steadfast and immovable in the hope of the gospel (Romans 5:3). Pray that you would make every effort to supplement your faith with godly virtues (2 Peter 1:5). As you have been set free from slavery to sin, pray that you will follow your new master Christ all the more (Romans 6).

Our Church's Faithfulness in Doctrine: As false prophets arose in the early church, false prophets are a perennial threat and reality in churches throughout the age (2 Peter 2:1). But those who hold fast and remember the truth of the gospel will be saved. Pray that our church corporately would never abandon the truths of the gospel. Pray that our members individually would hold fast to the confession of their hope (2 Peter 1:12-15; Heb. 10:23).

Our Community Groups: Pray that our CGs would continue to be places where true biblical community is practiced & preserved. Pray for individuals within CGs to eagerly practice the "one-anothers" of the New Testament – such as, love one another (Jn. 13:34), honor one another (Rom. 12:10), build up one another (Rom. 14:19), admonish one another (Rom. 15:14), serve one another (Gal. 5:13), bear one another's burdens (Gal. 6:2), and forgive one another (Eph. 4:2, 32).

The Unborn: As the Lord has given humanity a special place in his creation (Psalm 8) we know that human life is sacred. Ask the Lord to protect the lives of those not yet born (Psalm 139:13). Ask the Lord to help our state rule with justice that protects innocent life (Romans 13:1-7). Pray for mothers who may be considering an abortion to find great hope in the gospel of Jesus and practical help from Christians (1 John 3:17). Pray for the ministry of LifeForward to be effective in this work.

Hope for the Discouraged: Pray for those who are hurting, discouraged, depressed, lonely, and hopeless within our church family. Pray that they would know God's love for them (Eph. 3:14-19). Pray that they would sense the nearness of God (Ps. 34:18). Pray that they would put their hope and confidence in Christ alone (1 Pet. 1:3-6). Pray that our church would wrap our arms around them (Rom. 12:10-15).

The mission of Faith Church is to make more and better disciples here and around the world.

Corporate Prayer

Prayer is not just an optional extra but an essential component of what God's people are called to do when we gather (Acts 2:42, Acts 4:23-31, 2 Cor. 1:11). It is also a core responsibility for elders (1 Pet. 5:1-5; Acts 6:3). Sunday mornings are a great opportunity to lead in this way, as all of God's people at Faith Church are gathered together! So we will take time each week for extended, intentional prayer for spiritual matters, church family matters, regional & global matters, & for illumination as we prepare to hear the sermon.
