



WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

The Unborn: As Ohioans near an important vote on August 8th, pray our state government would work to protect the rights and worth of all peoples, including the unborn (1 Peter 2:13-14; Psalm 139:13). Ask that we as voters would rule wisely, being a terror to bad conduct not to good conduct (Romans 13:3). Pray that our government would rule in a way that properly reflect the unique value of human life (Psalm 8).

Fruit from Missionary Council: Pray for the missionary families our church served by running their VBS in Louisville. Pray that the children of these believers would trust Jesus as their savior and live their lives in obedience to him (Eph. 2:8-10). Pray for the missionaries to return to their work encouraged and energized in their ministry (Col. 1:11). Pray particularly for Blaine and Kelly Boyd, Nisin and Joana Mathew, and Chris and Lisa Phillips.

Fruit from OnGaol Soccer Camp: As children in our community gathered at the OnGoal facility this week to learn soccer and hear the gospel, pray that the Lord would see fit to save some of them. Pray that the gospel seed planted would bear fruit (Mark 4:20). Pray that families would come to our church as a result of this ministry to be evangelized, baptized, welcomed into our church, and discipled (Matthew 28:19-20).

Our Deacons: Pray for the 15 men and women who faithfully serve as our deacons at Faith Church. Pray for their ministry of service to our church family, as they visit the sick, distribute from the benevolence fund, pray for our people, provide for tangible needs, etc. (Acts 6:1-7). Pray also for Scott Ruotolo as he leads the team.

Unity in Diversity: Pray for our church to continue on in a spirit of love and unity (Romans 12:3-8). May we grow in diversity across many different cultural dividing lines. Pray that the unifying power of the gospel would be the thing that binds us together (John 17:20-26).

Benediction

We conclude our services each week with a benediction. which is a blessing for the road. The word "benediction" comes from the Latin for "a good word". One of our pastors or leaders will dismiss us with such a blessing, reminding us that the same God who gathers us also sends us out with his blessing, as his people, on mission to make more and better disciples. We see various benedictions in Scripture (Numbers 6:24-26; 2 Cor. 13:14; Hebrews 13:20-21; etc), and often use one of these or come up with our own. We raise our hands during the benediction as a sign of our unity with one another and receptiveness towards God's blessing.
