## WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

**The Unborn:** As Ohioans near an important vote on August 8th, pray our state government would work to protect the rights and worth of all peoples, including the unborn (1 Peter 2:13-14; Psalm 139:13). Ask that we as voters would rule wisely, being a terror to bad conduct not to good conduct (Romans 13:3). Pray that our government would rule in a way that properly reflects the unique value of human life (Psalm 8).

**The Allans:** The Allans are currently fundraising so Andy can start his new position at Cru headquarters in Florida in the fall. He will be leading and discipling a team of interns as well as managing in an HR role. Our church has supported this family for 20+ years and are encouraged by his increased role in shaping this important ministry. Pray for them to connect well with their current supporters and make new connections. Pray they can start in Florida soon and settle in smoothly. **The Allans are here with us today and will be for a few weeks. They would love to connect with people from their supporting church. They are very grateful for our continued support.**

**Our Humility and Love:** Pray we would do nothing out of selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility consider others as more important than ourselves (Phil. 2:3). Pray we would look out not only for our own interests, but also for the interests of others (Phil. 2:4). Pray we would adopt the same attitude of Christ, who humbled himself for our sake (Phil. 2:5-11).

**Those Struggling with Addictions:** Pray for those in our midst who are struggling with addictions. Pray that they would bring their struggles and frustrations to Jesus (Matt. 11:28-30). Pray they would repent of their sins and seek forgiveness (Mk. 1:14-15). Pray they would find practical wisdom (Prov. 3:21-23) and supportive friends in our church family (1 Thess. 5:11) that can help them live a stable, addiction-free, God-pleasing life (Phil. 2:12-16).

**Our Finances:** Pray that God would meet our financial needs (Phil. 4:19), so we can continue to do faithful gospel work in Cincinnati and beyond. Pray that we as a church would be faithful to contribute to the needs of the saints (Rom. 13:12). As we do this financially, pray that we would give cheerfully, generously, and sacrificially (1 Cor. 16:2; 2 Cor. 8:1-5, 12; 9:6-7).

The mission of Faith Church is to make more and better disciples here and around the world.

## WHY DO WE DO THAT?

### Gospel Liturgy

Every church uses a “liturgy” in their corporate worship. The liturgy is the form, traditions, and arrangements used in the worship service. At Faith Church, our liturgy is structured by 4 sections: God, Man, Christ, Response. While there’s no biblical mandate or instruction guide for the particular way to organize a Sunday Gathering, we want the liturgy of our Sunday Gathering to be shaped by the Gospel as much as possible. Every week, we are able to think on God’s holy nature & activity, the brokenness of sin in us & the world around us, the hope for pardon through Christ, and our faithful response as we are sent out to live in communion with God, in community with one another, and on mission to make disciples.
