WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

A New School Year: As a new school year begins, pray for those serving in our community as school superintendents, principals, administrators, and teachers. Pray the Lord would give them wisdom as they make decisions and work to protect and educate the students entrusted to their care. Pray too for students. Pray that they would work with diligence and put forward their best efforts (Prov. 13:4), and pray that as they learn more about the world God has made and grow in their understanding, they would behold the majesty of God's glory (Psalm 19:1).

Our Evangelism: Pray that we would increasingly grow in God's grace and in the knowledge of Christ as our Lord and Savior (2 Peter 3:17). Pray that the message of the gospel would be ready on our lips. Pray that we would develop gospel-oriented relationships and seize opportunities to proclaim the good news to those around us. Pray that we would increasingly find ways to weave our lives into the lives of those who need Jesus.

Other Gospel-Preaching Churches: Pray for other evangelical churches in our area. Pray they would continue to proclaim the excellencies of Christ and that they would remain committed to teach the whole counsel of God. Pray that these churches would be a vibrant and faithful witness to the hope of the gospel in our region. Pray the Lord would continue to build his church and establish healthy local churches throughout Cincinnati and beyond.

Hope for the Discouraged: Pray for those in our church family who are hurting, suffering, discouraged, depressed, lonely, and hopeless. Pray they would know God's love for them (Eph. 3:14-19). Pray they would sense the nearness of God (Ps. 34:18). Pray they would put their hope and confidence in Christ alone (1 Pet. 1:3-6). Pray our church would wrap our arms around them (Rom. 12:10-15).

Our Finances: Pray that God would meet our financial needs (Phil. 4:19), so we can continue to do faithful gospel work in Cincinnati and beyond. Pray that we as a church would be faithful to contribute to the needs of the saints (Rom. 13:12). As we do this financially, pray that we would give cheerfully, generously, and sacrificially (1 Cor. 16:2; 2 Cor. 8:1-5, 12; 9:6-7).

The mission of Faith Church is to make more and better disciples here and around the world.

WHY DO WE DO THAT?

Assurance of Pardon

Each week we take specific time to remember that even as we are broken and still struggling with sin, we can cling to the truth of God's assurance that we are pardoned and our sin debt is paid in full by Jesus (1 John 1:9; John 19:30; Col. 2:14). God does not intend to keep us doubting or uncertain of our standing before him. There is no condemnation for believers because God put our sin on Jesus and Jesus' righteousness on us (Romans 8:1; 2 Cor. 5:21). This reflection often happens through reading a passage of Scripture or singing a song that reminds us of our forgiven status as believers in Christ.
