


MOPS & MOMSnext Sept 11 - May 14 // 7-9pm



WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

Our Generosity: Ask that the Lord would grow our church in having generous hearts. May the abundance of God's goodness to us overflow in giving of our time, talent, and treasure. May we give cheerfully, not under compulsion. May the Lord see fit to use our gifts for his good purpose of building his kingdom (2 Corinthians 8-9).

Eternal Perspective: While our lives are objectively short and eternity is objectively long, we tend to forget to live with an eternal perspective (Revelation 4:8). Ask that the Lord would equip Faith Church with hearts that care about eternity. As church members die, may we grow in our reckoning with death (2 Corinthians 5:1-5). As we age, may we grow in our steadfast-anchor-of-the-soul hope in our resurrection life with Jesus (2 Corinthians 5:6-10).

Chris and Lisa Phillips: The Phillips are settling into a new life of ministry in Taiwan. They shared last week in our prayer service some specific requests: friends - for Chris and Lisa and their kids; fellowship - wisdom in whether to plant or revitalize a local church; fruit - faithful and fruitful evangelism; faith increase in their trust of Jesus.

Scott and Cherie Stober: The Stobers are traveling back to Papua New Guinea to transition to supporting locals to continue their translation work. Their prayer is to complete the Old Testament in one language, and to begin translations in three sister languages. Ask that the Lord would provide financially for this transition, and that he would provide godly locals to continue the work.

Our Deacons: Pray for the 15 men and women who faithfully serve as our deacons at Faith Church. Pray for their ministry of service to our church family, as they visit the sick, distribute from the benevolence fund, pray for our people, provide for tangible needs, etc. (Acts 6:1-7). Pray also for Scott Ruotolo as he leads the team.

WHY DO WE DO THAT?

Expository Preaching

The key word in "expository" is expose. In expository sermons, the main point of the sermon should expose the main point of the chosen text. For each text, our preachers consider the structure, literary context, historical setting, etc. Most importantly, we recognize that the entire Bible is ultimately about the person & work of Jesus Christ (Luke 24:44-49). As we work through Bible books, we trust that God's sheep will be fed a well-balanced diet & the church will be slowly molded into Christ's radiant bride (2 Cor. 11:2; Eph. 5:22-33). While our regular diet of preaching will work through books, we will occasionally do a topical series to address something the Elders believe is important (2 Tim. 4:1-5).
