





WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

Our Evangelism: Pray that we would increasingly grow in God's grace and in the knowledge of Christ as our Lord and Savior (2 Peter 3:17). Pray that the message of the gospel would be ready on our lips. Pray that we would develop gospel-oriented relationships and seize opportunities to proclaim the good news to those around us. Pray that we would increasingly find ways to weave our lives into the lives of those who need Jesus.

<u>Conversions:</u> Pray by name for unbelievers in your life. Pray for God to miraculously regenerate particular unbelievers who are connected to our members, as we welcome them to church or in our homes (Jn. 3:1-15). Pray that our unbelieving friends, neighbors, co-workers, and loved ones would hear the gospel and receive it with faith and repentance (Mk. 1:14-15). Pray that we would be bold in our evangelism and intentional in our invitations to church (Acts 4:23-31).

Our Humility and Love: Pray we would do nothing out of selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility consider others as more important than ourselves (Phil. 2:3). Pray we would look out not only for our own interests, but also for the interests of others (Phil. 2:4). Pray we would adopt the same attitude of Christ, who humbled himself for our sake (Phil. 2:5-11).

Charly & Christina Sommers: Pray for our supported partners, Charly and Christina Sommers, who serve with The Navigators. Pray for favor in all gospel conversations and relationships as college campus ministries begin. The next few weeks are critical. Pray for their own kids, Nathan, as he begins his college years at UC, and Grace as she finishes her last year. Pray for Charly as he starts traveling around to different venues as regional director and for Christina as she handles busy family and Navigator life. Praise the Lord for his faithfulness as they celebrate 26 years of marriage.

Our Finances: Pray that God would meet our financial needs (Phil. 4:19), so we can continue to do faithful gospel work in Cincinnati and beyond.
