



WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

Fruit from Larry Lamb's Funeral: We had the funeral for Larry Lamb yesterday. Pray for the Lord to comfort Erma (Isa. 29:13). Pray that those who heard the gospel in the service who do not know Jesus would respond in faith and repentance (Mk. 1:14-15). Pray that we would all learn the wisdom of numbering our days and living for eternity (Psalm 90:12).

Justice for the Unborn: As Ohioans near an important vote in November, pray our state government would work to protect the rights and worth of all people, including the unborn (1 Peter 2:13-14; Psalm 139:13). Ask that we as voters would rule wisely, being a terror to bad conduct not to good conduct (Rom. 13:3). Pray that our government would rule in a way that properly reflects the unique value of human life (Psalm 8).

Our Fighting Sin: In light of our sermon passage this morning, pray that the Lord would help Faith Church to take our sin very seriously (Mark 9:42-50). May he grant us repentance early and often. May we not be caught up in the deceitfulness of sin, but rather walk forward in gospel-fueled holiness (Hebrews 3:13).

Fruit from the Youth Retreat: Our youth just got back from a retreat weekend. In a series of three lessons, Pastor Ryan taught them some apologetic tools to present them with the urgent gospel message. Pray that this weekend would bear great fruit. Pray for students who have not yet repented and believed to do so. Pray for the Christian students to be equipped and encouraged in their evangelism.

Lynda Wick with Wycliffe Bible translators in PNG: She has rescheduled the Bible Background workshop in the Tami language group for April because the church there is erecting a new church building and it will not be ready in time. Lynda is scheduled to return to the USA for a visit in May 2024. Pray for her meetings with Yafed to be fruitful. Pray for continued healing of Emson's wife so she can join the team in October. Pray for the people from the Tami language group to be prepared to receive God's truth in God's timing. Pray that the church leaders who attended the circuit meeting in Wampar would go ahead with plans to request the scripture workshops and help organize them.

The mission of Faith Church is to make more and better disciples here and around the world.

WHY DO WE DO THAT?

Benediction

We conclude our services each week with a benediction, which is a blessing for the road. The word "benediction" comes from the Latin for "a good word". One of our pastors or leaders will dismiss us with such a blessing, reminding us that the same God who gathers us also sends us out with his blessing, as his people, on mission to make more and better disciples. We see various benedictions in Scripture (Numbers 6:24-26; 2 Cor. 13:14; Hebrews 13:20-21; etc), and often use one of these or come up with our own. We raise our hands during the benediction as a sign of our unity with one another and receptiveness towards God's blessing.
