



WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

Our Children & Youth: Thank God for the children and youth of our church! Pray that we would see them as a gift from the Lord and an integral part of our church family. Pray that our children will come to Jesus and enter his kingdom (Matt. 10:13-16). Pray their parents would be faithful to raise them in the fear and instruction of the Lord (Eph. 6:4). Pray for protection against the schemes of the devil and the pressures of the world that are especially challenging to our youth (Eph. 6:11). Pray that they will flee youthful passions and pursue righteousness, faith, love, and peace (2 Tim. 2:22).

<u>Justice for the Unborn:</u> As Ohioans near an important vote in November, pray our state government would work to protect the rights and worth of all people, including the unborn (1 Peter 2:13-14; Psalm 139:13). Ask that we as voters would rule wisely, being a terror to bad conduct, not to good conduct (Rom. 13:3). Pray that our government would rule in a way that properly reflects the unique value of human life (Psalm 8).

Conversions: Pray by name for unbelievers in your life. Pray for God to miraculously regenerate particular unbelievers who are connected to our members, as we welcome them to church or in our homes (Jn. 3:1-15). Pray that our unbelieving friends, neighbors, co-workers, and loved ones would hear the gospel and receive it with faith and repentance (Mk. 1:14-15). Pray that we would be bold in our evangelism and intentional in our invitations to church (Acts 4:23-31).

Mark and Marianne Householder | Athletes in Action: They hosted Chairman and CEO of the Kansas City Chiefs on the AIA campus. 40 others joined them to consider their part in helping to push their John Wooden Family Fieldhouse funding over the finish line. Pray that they would reach their fundraising goals. Mark has been leading Monday morning devotionals with the UC football coaches. Praise the Lord for this opportunity and pray that he will be able to organize special speakers for the program. Pray for Mark's health as he has been having heart problems. He is doing better and is grateful for gifted coworkers who have been stepping up to lead in his absence while he was in the hospital and who are helping as he has had to reduce his workload.

Gospel Liturgy

Every church uses a "liturgy" in their corporate worship. The liturgy is the form, traditions, and arrangements used in the worship service.
