WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

Conversions: Pray by name for unbelievers in your life. Pray for God to miraculously regenerate particular unbelievers who are connected to our members, as we welcome them to church or in our homes (Jn. 3:1-15). Pray that our unbelieving friends, neighbors, co-workers, and loved ones would hear the gospel and receive it with faith and repentance (Mk. 1:14-15). Pray that we would be bold in our evangelism and intentional in our invitations to church (Acts 4:23-31). Pray that the Lord would give us the gift as a church family of seeing someone come to faith in Jesus, baptize them, and welcome them into our membership.

Our Sanctification: As we face trials of various kinds, pray that you would remain steadfast and immovable in the hope of the gospel (Romans 5:3). Pray that you would make every effort to supplement your faith with godly virtues (2 Peter 1:5). As you have been set free from slavery to sin, pray that you will follow your new master Christ all the more (Romans 6).

Hope for the Discouraged: Pray for those who are hurting, discouraged, depressed, lonely, and hopeless within our church family. Pray that they would know God's love for them (Eph. 3:14-19). Pray that they would sense the nearness of God (Ps. 34:18). Pray that they would put their hope and confidence in Christ alone (1 Pet. 1:3-6). Pray that our church would wrap our arms around them (Rom. 12:10-15).

Unity in Diversity: Pray for our church to continue on in a spirit of love and unity (Romans 12:3-8). May we grow in diversity across many different cultural dividing lines. Pray that the unifying power of the gospel would be the thing that binds us together. (John 17:20-26).

Nisin and Joanna Mathew: Pray for Nisin as he leads FOCUS ministries reaching college students in the UAE with the gospel (John 3:16). As there are students from many countries closed to the gospel, or where there is minimal gospel witness, pray that God would use the ministry of FOCUS to reach the nations (Matthew 28:19). Pray that the FOCUS team would be encouraged in their ministry and bold with the gospel (1 Corinthians 2:2).

The mission of Faith Church is to make more and better disciples here and around the world.

Passing of the Peace

One of the most important effects of the Gospel is not only our unity with God, but our unity with one another (Ephesians 2:14-22; Galatians 3:28-29). 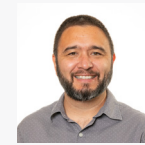

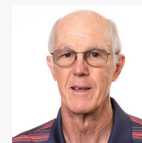

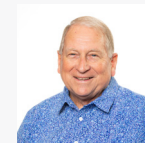
