WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

Deep Discipleship: Pray we would increasingly see following Jesus not as a solo endeavor, but as a team effort. Pray our growth in Christ would be deliberate and deep. Pray that members of Faith Church would flourish in their knowledge of Scripture and theology so that the roots of their faith grow deep and strong (2 Peter 3:17). Pray the Lord would use our Sunday morning worship gathering to energize and encourage such discipleship (Hebrews 10:24-26). Pray it would continue throughout the week in our community groups, discipling relationships, hospitality, Bible studies, and other opportunities the Lord may give us to do spiritual good for one another.

Our Evangelism: Pray that we would increasingly grow in God's grace and in the knowledge of Christ as our Lord and Savior (2 Peter 3:17). Pray that the message of the gospel would be ready on our lips. Pray that we would develop gospel-oriented relationships and seize opportunities to proclaim the good news to those around us (Acts 4:23-31). Pray that we would increasingly find ways to weave our lives into the lives of those who need Jesus.

<u>Justice for the Unborn:</u> As Ohioans near an important vote in November, pray our state government would work to protect the rights and worth of all people, including the unborn (1 Pet. 2:13-14; Ps. 139:13). Ask that we as voters would rule wisely, being a terror to bad conduct, not to good conduct (Romans 13:3). Pray that our government would rule in a way that properly reflects the unique value of human life (Psalm. 8).

<u>Our Homebound Members:</u> There are more than a dozen individuals who wish they could join us on Sunday mornings but are unable to do so due to health concerns. Please pray for their spiritual and emotional health and strength in the midst of their difficult challenges (Ephesians 3:14-21). Pray for their ability to be comforted by God's presence in the midst of their loneliness and isolation (Psalm 34:18). Pray for our church members and our deacons to find ways to connect with them and encourage them (Acts 6:1-7).

The mission of Faith Church is to make more and better disciples here and around the world.

WHY DO WE DO THAT?

Assurance of Pardon

After the confession, there will be an assurance of pardon moment. Often this will be taken from the scriptures, assuring Christians that God has pardoned their guilt, taken their sin away, and accepts them as His children forever (Ps. 103:1-8; Lk. 7:48-50; Jn. 3:16-17). Open your heart, each week, to be reminded of God's gracious pardon.
