WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

Men's Retreat: This past weekend, 55+ men from our church gathered for our men's retreat. Pray that the weekend will bear much spiritual fruit in the hearts of the men who attended. Pray that our men would increasingly use their words to build up, strengthen, and encourage their brothers and sisters in the church. Pray for new friendships and discipling relationships to be formed as a result of our time together. Pray all the men of our church would faithfully walk with God and pursue the honor of Christ in every sphere of their lives

Our Children & Youth: Thank God for the children and youth of our church! Pray we would see them as a gift from the Lord and an integral part of our church family.
