



WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

Our Thankfulness: Pray we would continue to grow to be a people who learn to give thanks in all circumstances, trusting that this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for us (1 Thess. 5:18). Pray the Lord would guard our hearts from grumbling, and instead lead us to be grateful for the good gifts he gives to his people. Pray our speech would be salted with thanksgiving (Eph. 5:3-4). As many of us gather with family and friends this week to celebrate the Thanksgiving holiday, pray we would give thanks to the Lord, for he is good and his love endures forever (Ps. 106:1).

Our Homebound Members: There are more than a dozen individuals who wish they could join us on Sunday mornings but are unable to do so due to health concerns. Please pray for their spiritual and emotional health and strength in the midst of their difficult challenges. Pray for their ability to be comforted by God's presence in the midst of their loneliness and isolation.
