Christmas Carol Sing Dec 15 // 6:30pm // Sanctuary





WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

Fruit from Carolyn Konold's Service: Pray for fruit from the service we had yesterday celebrating God's work of grace in the life of Carolyn Konold, one of our members who passed from this life on November 21. Praise God that Carolyn's faith has finally become sight. Pray that the gospel preached vesterday would convict non-Christians who attended, and that we would be spurred onto greater hope in the promise of the resurrection. Pray that Carolyn's family would know the comfort of God, who is near to the brokenhearted and saves the crushed in spirit (Psalm 34:18).

Our Elders: Pray they would watch their life and doctrine closely, and that they would do nothing to disqualify them from their service (1 Tim. 3:1-7; 4:16). Pray they would shepherd the flock of Faith Church not out of compulsion, but willingly; not for shameful gain, but eagerly; not domineering over those in their charge, but being examples to the flock (1 Peter 5:2-3).

Our Homebound Members: There are more than a dozen individuals who wish they could join us on Sunday mornings but are unable to do so due to health concerns. Please pray for their spiritual and emotional health and strength in the midst of their difficult challenges. Pray for their ability to be comforted by God's presence in the midst of their loneliness and isolation. Pray for our church members and our deacons to find ways to connect with them and encourage them.

Conversions: Pray by name for unbelievers in your life. Pray for God to miraculously regenerate particular unbelievers who are connected to our members, as we welcome them to church or in our homes (Jn. 3:1-15). Pray that our unbelieving friends, neighbors, co-workers, and loved ones would hear the gospel and receive it with faith and repentance (Mk. 1:14-15). Pray that we would be bold in our evangelism and intentional in our invitations to church (Acts 4:23-31).

Other Gospel-Preaching Churches: Pray for other evangelical churches in our area. Pray they would continue to proclaim the excellencies of Christ and that they would remain committed to teach the whole counsel of God. Pray the Lord would continue to build his church and establish healthy local churches throughout Cincinnati and beyond.

Sermon
