## WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

**Fruit from Hugh's Funeral:** Yesterday we celebrated longtime member Hugh Smith's life. His wife, Riona, shared her desire to "Celebrate Hugh's life and magnify the Lord." Pray that those who took the time to consider Hugh's life will be encouraged and emboldened to live for eternity. Pray for his family and friends who will be grieving his death. Pray for those who knew him who didn't know the Lord to be challenged with the reality of death and their need for gospel hope.

**Fruit from Bob Smith's Funeral:** Bob Smith's funeral will be this coming Thursday. Similarly to Hugh's, pray that the Lord would use the occasion of his death to bring about spiritual fruit in believers and non-believers alike.

Hope for the Discouraged around Christmas: Pray for those in our church family who are hurting, suffering, discouraged, depressed, lonely, and hopeless. Pray they would know God's love for them (Ephesians 3:14-19). Pray they would sense the nearness of God (Psalm 34:18). Pray they would put their hope and confidence in Christ alone (1 Peter 1:3-6). Pray our church would wrap our arms around them (Romans 12:10-15).

Our Children: Pray for the sons and daughters that the Lord has blessed us with. Pray that our sons will grow to be men of God who are equipped for every good work and able to lead boldly in a world antagonistic to the gospel (2 Tim. 3:16-17). Pray for our daughters to become godly women who are compassionate disciple-makers and pure in heart (Titus 2:3-5).

Advent Evangelism: As our culture celebrates Christmas, pray that the message of the gospel would be ready on our lips. Pray that we would develop gospel-oriented relationships and seize opportunities to proclaim the good news to those around us (Acts 4:23-31). Pray that we would increasingly find ways to weave our lives into the lives of those who need Jesus. The mission of Faith Church is to make more and better disciples here and around the world.

#### **Call to Worship & Prayer of Adoration**
