


Lessons and Carols Service Dec 24 // 7pm // Sanctuary

Faith Church Office Closed Dec 25 - 28 & Jan 1, 2024







WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

Fruit from Bob Smith's Service: Pray for fruit from the service we had on Thursday remembering the life of Bob Smith, a long-time attender of Faith Church who recently passed away. Pray the gospel that was preached would convict non-Christians who attended, and that we would be spurred onto greater hope in the promise of the resurrection. Pray that Bob's family, and especially his wife Carol, would know the comfort of God, who is near to the brokenhearted and saves the crushed in spirit (Psalm 34:18).

Unity in Diversity: Pray for our church to continue on in a spirit of love and unity (Romans 12:3-8). May we grow in diversity across many different cultural dividing lines. Pray that the unifying power of the gospel would be the thing that binds us together. (John 17:20-26).

Our Sanctification: As we face trials of various kinds, pray that you would remain steadfast and immovable in the hope of the gospel (Romans 5:3). Pray that you would make every effort to supplement your faith with godly virtues (2 Peter 1:5). As you have been set free from slavery to sin, pray that you will follow your new master Christ all the more (Romans 6).

Our Generosity: Ask that the Lord would grow our church in having generous hearts. May the abundance of God's goodness to us overflow in giving of our time, talent, and treasure. May we give cheerfully, not under compulsion. May the Lord see fit to use our gifts for his good purpose of building his kingdom (2 Corinthians 8-9).

Advent Evangelism: As our culture celebrates Christmas, pray that the message of the gospel would be ready on our lips. Pray that we would develop gospel-oriented relationships and seize opportunities to proclaim the good news to those around us (Acts 4:23-31). Pray that we would increasingly find ways to weave our lives into the lives of those who need Christ.
