



#### WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

Faith Church in 2024: Pray for Faith Church in 2024 to make more and better disciples. Pray for her elders to be faithful and wise. Pray for her members to be growing in pleasing the Lord in all of life (2 Cor. 5:9). Pray that the Lord would use our ministry to bring many in our community to Faith. ## WHY DO WE DO THAT?

#### The Lord's Supper

We take the Lord's Supper each week to remind one another of the Lord's death, by proclaiming it through the bread and the cup (1 Corinthians 11:17-34). To keep this from becoming rote, think deeply about what the bread and cup represent - the broken bread illustrates his broken body, and the cup portrays his shed blood. Recognize your great need for a Merciful Savior. Celebrate the good news of the Cross.
