WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

A Praying Church: Ask that we will always pray and not lose heart as the year goes on (Luke 18:1). Ask that we may see what a tremendous privilege it is that we are invited and encouraged to draw near to God in prayer (James 4:8). Ask that by God's grace we will daily bring our praises, confessions, petitions, thanksgivings, and intercessions. Ask that as a church, we will devote ourselves to praying together more (Acts 1:14). Pray that the Spirit will help us in our weaknesses and teach us how to pray (Romans 8:26).

A Loving Church: Pray we will love the Lord our God with all our hearts, all our souls, all our minds and all our strength. And that we will love our neighbor as ourselves (Mark 12:30-31). Ask that as a church we will put on that love which binds everything together in perfect harmony (Col. 3:14). Pray that our love will naturally lead to a fulfillment of the law (Romans 13:9-10) and that we will love one another earnestly from a pure heart (1 Peter. 1:22) that by this all men may know that we are Christ's disciples (John. 13:35).

A Believing Church: Pray that our faith will increase and grow throughout the year (Luke 17:5, Romans 4:20). Ask that by his grace, we will trust in the good news and the many promises of his word so that we may receive all the intended benefits (Hebrews 4:2). Pray that as we face various trials in the coming year our faith will prove genuine and result in praise and glory and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ (1 Peter 1:7). Even though we cannot see him with our eyes now, pray that we will believe in him and rejoice with inexpressible and glorious joy as we receive the goal of our faith, the salvation of our souls (1 Peter 1:8).

A Witnessing Church: Pray that the message of the gospel would be ready on our lips and that we will always be prepared to give reasons for the hope that is in us (1 Peter 3:15). Ask that many doors will open for the word and that we will declare the mystery of Christ with clarity and winsomeness (Colossians 3:3-4). Pray that many unbelievers who visit our church and interact with our people will be converted and able to say, "We no longer believe because of what you said, since we have heard for ourselves and know that this really is the Savior of the world" (John 4:42).

The mission of Faith Church is to make more and better disciples here and around the world.

WHY DO WE DO THAT?

Benediction

"Benediction" means "blessing." We close our worship services with a blessing for the road. This is a pronouncement of blessing upon God's people, as they prepare to leave the gathering of God's people and scatter into the world. We raise our hands during the benediction as a sign of our unity with one another and receptiveness towards God's blessing.

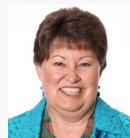

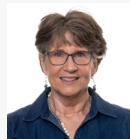
