



WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

Our Community Groups: Pray for our various community groups as they meet throughout the week. Pray they would continue to be places where true biblical community is practiced & preserved. Pray for us to eagerly practice the "one-anothers" of the New Testament. Pray our groups would be places where we love one another (Jn. 13:34), honor one another (Rom. 12:10), build up one another (Rom. 14:19), admonish one another (Rom. 15:14), serve one another (Gal. 5:13), bear one another's burdens (Gal. 6:2), and forgive one another (Eph. 4:2, 32).
