

WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

A Praying Church: Ask that we will always pray and not lose heart (Luke 18:1). Ask that we may see what a tremendous privilege it is that we are invited and encouraged to draw near to God in prayer (James 4:8). Ask that by God's grace we will daily bring our praises, confessions, petitions, thanksgivings, and intercessions. Ask that as a church, we will devote ourselves to praying together more (Acts 1:14). Pray that the Spirit will help us in our weaknesses and teach us how to pray (Romans 8:26).

Hope for the Hurting: Pray for those in our church family who are hurting, suffering, discouraged, depressed, lonely, hopeless, etc. Ask for true comfort to come to those who have lost loved ones, that they may truly know that the LORD is near them (Psalm 34:18). Pray for those whose health is failing that they may find healing and be strengthened with all power according to His glorious might (Colossians 1:11). Pray for the grace to rejoice in hope, be patient in tribulation, and be constant in prayer (Romans 12:12) even the midst of great difficulties.

Our Humility and Love: Pray we would do nothing out of selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility consider others as more important than ourselves (Phil. 2:3). Pray we would look out not only for our own interests, but also for the interests of others (Phil. 2:4). Pray we would adopt the same attitude of Christ, who humbled himself for our sake (Phil. 2:5-11).

Our Elders: Pray they would watch their life and doctrine closely, and that they would do nothing to disqualify them from their service (1 Tim. 3:1-7; 4:16). Pray they would shepherd the flock of Faith Church not out of compulsion, but willingly: not for shameful gain, but eagerly; not domineering over those in their charge, but being examples to the flock (1 Peter 5:2-3).

Evangelical Free Church | Reach Global: Continue to pray for peace, both in Ukraine and in the Middle East. The EFCA has church planting endeavors in both war-torn areas. The work is difficult. Our brothers and sisters there need prayer for safety and encouragement.

The mission of Faith Church is to make more and better disciples here and around the world.
