



WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

The Suffering: Pray for those who are experiencing a widerange of suffering among us. Pray for those with prolonged and chronic sickness. Pray for those who are fainthearted and discouraged. Pray for infertile couples in the congregation who are discouraged. Pray for those who have suffered miscarriages. Pray for those dealing with the grief that lingers from the death of a spouse, child, or family member. Pray for parents of wayward adult children.

Our Homebound Members: There are more than a dozen members who wish they could join us on Sunday mornings but are unable to do so due to health and physical limitations. Please pray for their spiritual and emotional health and strength in the midst of their difficult challenges. Pray for their ability to be comforted by God's presence in the midst of their loneliness and isolation. Pray we would be intentional and faithful to find ways to connect with them and encourage them.

<u>Unity in Diversity:</u> Pray for our church to continue on in a spirit of love and unity (Romans 12:3-8). May we grow in diversity across many different cultural dividing lines. Pray that the unifying power of the gospel would be the thing that binds us together (John 17:20-26).
