


Deacon Ministry - Meals Ministry





WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

Hope for the Hurting: Pray for those in our church family who are hurting, suffering, discouraged, depressed, lonely, hopeless, etc. Ask for true comfort to come to those who have lost loved ones, that they may truly know that the LORD is near them (Ps. 34:18). Pray for those whose health is failing that they may find healing and be strengthened with all power according to His glorious might (Col. 1:11). Pray for the grace to rejoice in hope, be patient in tribulation, and be constant in prayer (Rom. 12:12) even the midst of great difficulties.

Our Children & Youth: Thank God for the children and youth of our church! Pray we would see them as a gift from the Lord and an integral part of our church family. Pray that our children will come to Jesus and enter his kingdom (Matt. 10:13-16). Pray their parents would be faithful to raise them in the fear and instruction of the Lord (Eph. 6:4). Pray for protection against the schemes of the devil and the pressures of the world that are especially challenging to our youth (Eph. 6:11). Pray that they will flee youthful passions and pursue righteousness, faith, love, and peace (2 Tim. 2:22).

Conversions: Pray by name for unbelievers in your life. Pray for God to miraculously regenerate particular unbelievers who are connected to our members, as we welcome them to church or in our homes (Jn. 3:1-15). Pray that our unbelieving friends, neighbors, co-workers, and loved ones would hear the gospel and receive it with faith and repentance (Mark 1:14-15). Pray that Faith Church folks would be bold in their evangelism and intentional in their invitations to church (Acts 4:23-31).

Cedarville Men's Soccer Team Mission Trip: Pray for the Cedarville men's soccer team, including our own Landon Cornwall, as they travel to Medellin, Colombia on a mission trip from March 2-11. They are participating through Cedarville Global Outreach and partnering with the Chicago Eagles and Missionary Athletes International. Pray for the gospel to be declared and demonstrated in love by the team, that many would receive Christ, that the full-time missionaries serving there would be blessed by the team, that the men would be transformed to be more like Christ, for continued financial support, and for safety and health throughout the trip.
