



WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

The Faithful Parenting Conference: Pray for good spiritual fruit from our Faithful Parenting Conference coming up in April. May parents take steps forward in their own holiness. May their parenting skills be improved. May the progress in this conference have good spiritual impact for decades to come.

The Congregational Meeting: As our church gathers next week for our annual meeting, pray that we can continue to glorify Jesus and love one another well.
