WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

The Faithful Parenting Conference: Continue to pray for good spiritual fruit from our Faithful Parenting Conference next weekend. Pray that parents would be encouraged in their efforts to disciple and train their children in the fear and instruction of the Lord. Pray parents take steps forward in their own holiness and parenting skills. Pray God would be glorified in our parenting. Pray the children of our church would flourish under the care of their parents. May the progress in this conference have good spiritual impact for decades to come.

<u>Our Humility and Love:</u> Pray we would do nothing out of selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility consider others as more important than ourselves (Phil. 2:3). Pray we would look out not only for our own interests, but also for the interests of others (Phil. 2:4). Pray we would adopt the same attitude of Christ, who humbled himself for our sake (Phil. 2:5-11).

She engaged with university students and laid down relational groundwork for those who will come back in the fall. WHY DO WE DO THAT?

Confession of Sin & Prayer of Confession

God commands His people to continually confess their sins to Him (1 Jn. 1:9). The service leader will lead us in a moment of confession (often a short time of silence for self-examination and private confession). This may also include scripture reading, a responsive prayer of confession, or a corporate prayer of confession that the service leader will lead. We want to be a people who continually repent of their sins and experience the mercy of God! Lean into this moment.
