



WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

Conversions: Pray by name for unbelievers in your life. Pray for God to miraculously regenerate particular unbelievers who are connected to our members, as we welcome them to church or in our homes (John 3:1-15). Pray that our unbelieving friends, neighbors, co-workers, and loved ones would hear the gospel and receive it with faith and repentance (Mark 1:14-15). Pray that Faith Church folks would be bold in their evangelism and intentional in their invitations to church (Acts 4:23-31).

Karen Norton: Karen is heading to Albania in the fall for a year-long STINT trip with Athletes in Action. During her recent trip to Albania, she learned a lot about the country and its people. She engaged with university students and laid down relational groundwork for those who will come back in the fall.
