


Membership Class April 21 // 12:15-3:30pm // Rm 8



WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

The Revelation Series: Pray for spiritual fruit as we study the book of Revelation. May we be blessed by obeying these words (Rev. 1:3). May we have greater worship of the victorious King Jesus (Rev. 1:6). May we have greater hope in the victory of the lamb (Rev. 5:6). May we maintain the unity of the bond of peace (Eph. 4:3).

<u>Our Elders:</u> Pray they would watch their life and doctrine closely, and that they would do nothing to disqualify them from their service (1 Tim. 3:1-7; 4:16). Pray they would shepherd the flock of Faith Church not out of compulsion, but willingly; not for shameful gain, but eagerly; not domineering over those in their charge, but being examples to the flock (1 Peter 5:2-3).

Our Homebound Members: There are more than a dozen members who wish they could join us on Sunday mornings but are unable to do so due to health and physical limitations. Please pray for their spiritual and emotional health and strength in the midst of their difficult challenges. Pray for their ability to be comforted by God's presence in the midst of their loneliness and isolation. Pray we would be intentional and faithful to find ways to connect with them and encourage them.

A Praying Church: Ask that we will always pray and not lose heart (Luke 18:1). Ask that we may see what a tremendous privilege it is that we are invited and encouraged to draw near to God in prayer (James 4:8). Ask that by God's grace we will daily bring our praises, confessions, petitions, thanksgivings, and intercessions. Ask that as a church, we will devote ourselves to praying together more (Acts 1:14). Pray that the Spirit will help us in our weaknesses and teach us how to pray (Romans 8:26).

Nancy and Jeff Haney | Hands for Vietnam: The Haney family will be traveling to Vietnam in May. While they are there, they will spend time with the students and staff, attend the 10th anniversary celebration, and participate in the summer camp, staff retreat, and training time. Pray that they will have a safe and productive trip. Pray that the staff there will communicate the love of Jesus to the students.
