





WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

The Revelation Series: Pray for much spiritual fruit as we study the book of Revelation. Ask that we would be in awe of this glorious Jesus that we see (Rev. 1:12-16) and that we would respond with John by falling down at his feet in worship (Rev. 1:17). Pray that we would find hope in the fact that Jesus is the Living One, who died but has been raised and is now alive forever and ever (Rev. 1:17-18). Rejoice that because he lives, we too can find eternal life in him

Our Children & Youth: Thank God for the children and youth of our church! Pray we would see them as a gift from the Lord and an integral part of our church family. Pray that our children will come to Jesus and enter his kingdom (Matt. 10:13-16). Pray their parents would be faithful to raise them in the fear and instruction of the Lord (Eph. 6:4). Pray for protection against the schemes of the devil and the pressures of the world that are especially challenging to our youth (Eph. 6:11). Pray that they will flee youthful passions and pursue righteousness, faith, love, and peace (2 Tim. 2:22).
