WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

Our Community Groups: Pray for our various community groups as they meet throughout the week. Pray they would continue to be places where true biblical community is practiced & preserved. Pray for us to eagerly practice the “one-anothers” of the New Testament. Pray our groups would be places where we love one another (Jn. 13:34), honor one another (Rom. 12:10), build up one another (Rom. 14:19), admonish one another (Rom. 15:14), serve one another (Gal. 5:13), bear one another’s burdens (Gal. 6:2), and forgive one another (Eph. 4:2, 32).

Fruit from the Preaching of God’s Word: Pray that God’s Word, as it’s preached each week, will do its work of rebuking, correcting, and training in righteousness so that we would be “made complete, equipped for every good work” (2 Tim. 3:16-17). Pray for our pastors, as they labor each week, to preach faithfully, clearly, with great patience, in Christ-exalting ways, and in accordance with sound doctrine (2 Tim. 4:1-3).

Our Staff: Pray for the faithful men and women who serve on staff at Faith Church. Thank God for their gospel partnership and willingness to lead, serve behind-the-scenes to support our church, minister God’s Word, and shepherd the flock (Phil. 1:3-5). Pray for them to be encouraged and find joy in their work. Pray that they will serve in the strength that God supplies and that in everything they do God will be glorified through Jesus Christ (1 Pet. 4:11).

The Suffering: Pray for those who are experiencing a wide range of suffering among us. Pray for those with prolonged and chronic sickness. Pray for those who are fainthearted and tempted to despair. Pray for infertile couples in the congregation who are discouraged. Pray for those dealing with the grief that lingers from the death of a spouse, child, or family member. Pray for parents of wayward adult children.

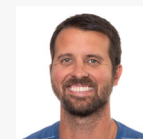

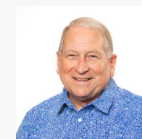
