WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

Deep Discipleship: Pray we would increasingly see following Jesus not as a solo endeavor, but as a team effort. Pray our growth in Christ would be deliberate and deep. Pray that members of Faith Church would flourish in their knowledge of Scripture and theology so that the roots of their faith grow deep and strong (2 Peter 3:17). Pray the Lord would use our Sunday morning worship gathering to energize and encourage such discipleship (Hebrews 10:24-26). Pray it would continue throughout the week in our community groups, discipling relationships, hospitality, Bible studies, and other opportunities the Lord may give us to do spiritual good for one another.

Our Congregational Singing: Pray we would be a church that delights to “sing to the LORD a new song, his praise in the assembly of the godly” (Psalm 149:1). Pray that we would sing with full hearts as an act of love toward God and one another. Pray we would see our singing on Sundays as expressions of our faith and thankfulness to God and as a means to teach, admonish, and encourage one another (Ephesians 5:18-20).

Our Elders: Pray they would watch their life and doctrine closely, and that they would do nothing to disqualify them from their service (1 Timothy 3:1-7; 4:16). Pray they would shepherd the flock of Faith Church not out of compulsion, but willingly; not for shameful gain, but eagerly; not domineering over those in their charge, but being examples to the flock (1 Peter 5:2-3). Pray that the Lord would continue to raise up more faithful men who are qualified to serve us as elders.

Our Generosity: Ask that the Lord would grow our church in having generous hearts. May the abundance of God’s goodness to us overflow in giving of our time, talent, and treasure. May we give cheerfully, not under compulsion. May the Lord see fit to use our gifts for his good purpose of building his kingdom (2 Corinthians 8-9).

Other Gospel-Preaching Churches: Pray for other evangelical churches in our area. Pray they would continue to proclaim the excellencies of Christ and that they would remain committed to teach the whole counsel of God. Pray the Lord would continue to build his church and establish healthy local churches throughout Cincinnati and beyond.

The mission of Faith Church is to make more and better disciples here and around the world.

WHY DO WE DO THAT?

Gospel Liturgy

“Liturgy” literally means “the work of the people” or “public” (leito) “works” (ergos). Author Bryan Chapell defines it as the public way a church honors God in its times of gathered praise, prayer, instruction, and commitment. It’s the work of the people to give praise and honor that God is due. We use “gospel liturgy” to mean that its parts work together to disciple people in the movements of the gospel: God; Man; Christ; Response. These four elements shape our worship services, which we want to humble us and exalt the grace of God that is in Christ Jesus. Our hope each week is for people to be formed and re-formed by the gospel of Jesus Christ.

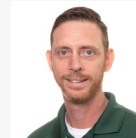
