## WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

**Our Congregational Singing:** Pray we would be a church that delights to “sing to the LORD a new song, his praise in the assembly of the godly” (Psalm 149:1). Pray that we would sing with full hearts as an act of love toward God and one another. Pray we would see our singing on Sundays as expressions of our faith and thankfulness to God and as a means to teach, admonish, and encourage one another (Ephesians 5:18-20).

**Unity in Diversity:** Pray for our church to continue on in a spirit of love and unity (Romans 12:3-8). May we grow in diversity across many different cultural dividing lines. Pray that the unifying power of the gospel would be the thing that binds us together (John 17:20-26).

**Our Staff:** Pray for the faithful men and women who serve on staff at Faith Church. Thank God for their gospel partnership and willingness to lead, serve behind-the-scenes to support our church, minister God’s Word, and shepherd the flock (Philippians 1:3-5). Pray for them to be encouraged and find joy in their work. Pray that they will serve in the strength that God supplies and that in everything they do God will be glorified through Jesus Christ (1 Peter 4:11).

**Our Elders:** Pray they would watch their life and doctrine closely and that they would do nothing to disqualify them from their service (1 Timothy 3:1-7; 4:16). Pray they would shepherd the flock not out of compulsion, but willingly; not for shameful gain, but eagerly; not domineering over those in their charge, but being examples to the flock (1 Peter 5:2-3).

**Eternal Perspective:** While our lives are objectively short and eternity is objectively long, we tend to forget to live with an eternal perspective (Revelation 4:8). Ask that the Lord would equip Faith Church with hearts that care about eternity. As we study Ecclesiastes, may we grow in our reckoning with death and the shortness of “life under the sun”. As we encounter the fleeting nature of life, may we grow in our steadfast-anchor-of-the-soul hope in our resurrection life with Jesus (2 Corinthians 5:6-10).

The mission of Faith Church is to make more and better disciples here and around the world.

## WHY DO WE DO THAT?

### Assurance of Pardon

After the confession, there will be an assurance of pardon moment. Often this will be taken from the scriptures, assuring Christians that God has pardoned their guilt, taken their sin away, and accepts them as His children forever (Psalm 103:1-8; Luke 7:48-50; John 3:16-17). Open your heart, each week, to be reminded of God’s gracious pardon.

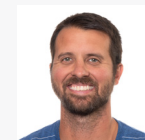
