WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

Conversions: Pray by name for unbelievers in your life. Pray for God to miraculously regenerate particular unbelievers who are connected to our members as we welcome them to church or in our homes (John 3:1-15). Pray that our unbelieving friends, neighbors, co-workers, and loved ones would hear the gospel and receive it with faith and repentance (Mark 1:14-15). Pray that we would be bold in our evangelism and intentional in our invitations to church (Acts 4:23-31).

Our Elders: Pray they would watch their life and doctrine closely, and that they would do nothing to disqualify them from their service (1 Tim. 3:1-7; 4:16). Pray they would shepherd the flock not out of compulsion, but willingly; not for shameful gain, but eagerly; not domineering over those in their charge, but being examples to the flock (1 Peter 5:2-3).

Our Deacons: Pray for the men and women who faithfully serve as our deacons. Pray for their ministry of service to our church family as they visit the sick, distribute from the benevolence fund, work to strengthen our unity, pray for our people, provide for tangible needs, etc. (Acts 6:1-7).

Eternal Perspective: While our lives are objectively short and eternity is objectively long, we tend to forget to live with an eternal perspective (Revelation 4:8). Ask that the Lord would equip Faith Church with hearts that care about eternity. As we study Ecclesiastes, may we grow in our reckoning with death and the shortness of "life under the sun". As we encounter the fleeting nature of life, may we grow in our steadfast-anchor-of-the-soul hope in our resurrection life with Jesus (2 Corinthians 5:6-10).

Our Finances: Pray that God would meet our financial needs (Philippians 4:19) so we can continue to do faithful gospel work in Cincinnati and beyond. Pray that we as a church would be faithful to contribute to the needs of the saints (Romans 13:12) giving cheerfully, generously, and sacrificially (1 Corinthians 16:2; 2 Corinthians 8:1-5, 12; 9:6-7).

The mission of Faith Church is to make more and better disciples here and around the world.

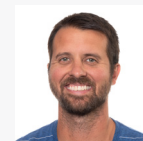

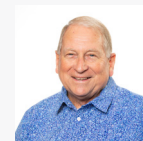
