WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

The Suffering: Pray for those who are experiencing a wide range of suffering among us. Pray for those with prolonged and chronic sickness. Pray for those who are fainthearted and tempted to despair. Pray for infertile couples in the congregation who are discouraged. Pray for those who have suffered miscarriages. Pray for those dealing with the grief that lingers from the death of a spouse, child, or family member. Pray for parents of wayward adult children.

Our Children & Youth: Thank God for the children and youth of our church! Pray we would see them as a gift from the Lord and an integral part of our church family. Pray that our children will come to Jesus and enter his kingdom (Matthew 10:13-16). Pray their parents would be faithful to raise them in the fear and instruction of the Lord (Ephesians 6:4). 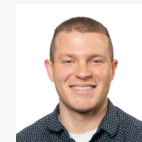

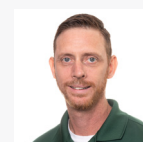
