WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

New Members: Pray for the incoming members introduced to the congregation at the last meeting. May the Lord knit their hearts to ours in gospel-fueled love. May we care well for their needs, bear up with their weaknesses, and spur them on to greater holiness (Eph. 4:32; Rom. 15:1; 1 Thess. 5:11). May our various gifts build up the body of Christ in love (1 Cor. 12).

Our Wisdom: Pray that we will grow as a church in wisdom. May we live well under the sun (Ecc. 1:3). May we live in light of death and in light of eternity (Ecc. 1:2). May we fear God in all things (Ecc. 5:7). Pray that the sermon series through Ecclesiastes has a lasting impact on our collective wisdom.

Our Staff: Pray for the faithful men and women who serve on staff at Faith Church. Thank God for their gospel partnership and willingness to lead, serve behind-the-scenes to support our church, minister God's Word, and shepherd the flock (Phil. 1:3-5). Pray for them to be encouraged and find joy in their work. Pray that they will serve in the strength that God supplies and that in everything they do God will be glorified through Jesus Christ (1 Pet. 4:11).

A Praying Church: Ask that we will always pray and not lose heart (Lk. 18:1). Ask that we may see what a tremendous privilege it is that we are invited and encouraged to draw near to God in prayer (James 4:8). Ask that by God's grace we will daily bring our praises, confessions, petitions, thanksgivings, and intercessions. Ask that as a church, we will devote ourselves to praying together more (Acts 1:14). Pray that the Spirit will help us in our weaknesses and teach us how to pray (Rom. 8:26).

Our Governing Authorities: Pray for our current governing authorities like President Trump and Governor Mike DeWine (1 Tim. 2:1-4). Pray that they would lead with character, wisdom, and care for all. Pray for effective governmental leadership, "so that we may lead a tranquil and quiet life in all godliness and dignity."

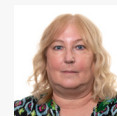

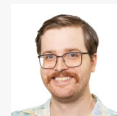

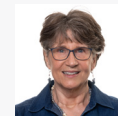
