## WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

**Our Love and Discernment:** Pray that Faith Church will grow abundantly in love for the Lord and for one another (Mk. 12:30-31). May we put the interests of others over our own interests (Phil. 2:4). In doing that, may we be increasingly like Jesus (Phil. 2:5). In addition to this, may our discernment grow all the more (Phil. 2:9). May we approve what is excellent, and so be pure and blameless for the day of Christ (Phil. 2:10).

**For the Nations:** Pray that all the ends of the earth will remember and turn to the Lord and that every family of every nation will worship the Lord (Ps. 22:27). Pray that every people, nation, and language will serve King Jesus (Dan. 7:14). Choose one nation in particular and pray for it each day this week that Jesus might be glorified there and much good would come to the people. Rejoice and praise God that by his blood, Jesus has ransomed people for God from every tribe and language and people and nation (Rev. 5:9).

**Chris and Lisa Phillips:** Pray for for Chris and Lisa Phillips as they serve in their new church plant in East Asia. Pray for Chris as he bears the load of being the main preaching pastor. Pray for their kids to grow in wisdom and stature. Pray that many would be saved through the witness of their church.

**Our Governing Authorities:** Pray for our current governing authorities like President Trump and Governor Mike DeWine (1 Tim. 2:1-4). Pray that they would lead with character, wisdom, and care for all. Pray for effective governmental leadership, “so that we may lead a tranquil and quiet life in all godliness and dignity.”

### Call to Worship & Prayer of Adoration

We do not invite ourselves to worship God; rather, God has called us to worship Him. God initiates; we respond. He has the first and last word in meeting with us.
