WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

Conversions: Pray by name for unbelievers in your life. Pray for God to miraculously give new and eternal life to particular unbelievers who are connected to our members as we welcome them to church or in our homes (John 3:1-15). Pray that our unbelieving friends, neighbors, co-workers, and loved ones would hear the gospel and receive it with faith and repentance (Mark 1:14-15). Pray that we would be bold in our evangelism and intentional in our invitations to church (Acts 4:23-31).

The Suffering: Pray for those who are experiencing a wide range of suffering among us. Pray for those who are in the final chapter of life and are in desperate need of the Lord's comforting presence. Pray for those with prolonged and chronic sickness. Pray for those who are fainthearted and tempted to despair. Pray for infertile couples in the congregation who are discouraged and for those who have suffered miscarriages. Pray for those dealing with the grief that lingers from the death of a spouse, child, or family member. Pray for parents of wayward adult children.

Our Elders: Pray that our elders will have great wisdom as they seek to lead our church through this next season. Pray they would watch their life and doctrine closely and that they would do nothing to disqualify them from their service (1 Timothy 3:1-7; 4:16). Pray they would shepherd the flock not out of compulsion, but willingly; not for shameful gain, but eagerly; not domineering over those in their charge, but being examples to the flock (1 Peter 5:2-3).

A Loving Church: Pray that we will love the Lord our God with all our hearts, all our souls, all our minds, and all our strength. And that we will love our neighbor as ourselves (Mark 12:30-31). Ask that as a church we will put on that love which binds everything together in perfect harmony (Colossians 3:14). Pray that our love will naturally lead to a fulfillment of the law (Romans 13:9-10) and that we will love one another earnestly from a pure heart (1 Peter 1:22) that by this all men may know that we are Christ's disciples (John 13:35).

The mission of Faith Church is to make more and better disciples here and around the world.

WHY DO WE DO THAT?

Confession of Sin & Prayer of Confession

God commands His people to continually confess their sins to Him (1 John 1:9). The service leader will lead us in a moment of confession (often a short time of silence for self-examination and private confession). This may also include scripture reading, a responsive prayer of confession, or a corporate prayer of confession that the service leader will lead. We want to be a people who continually repent of their sins and experience the mercy of God! Lean into this moment.

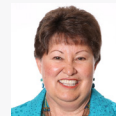

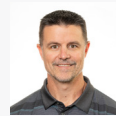

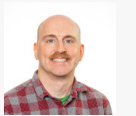
