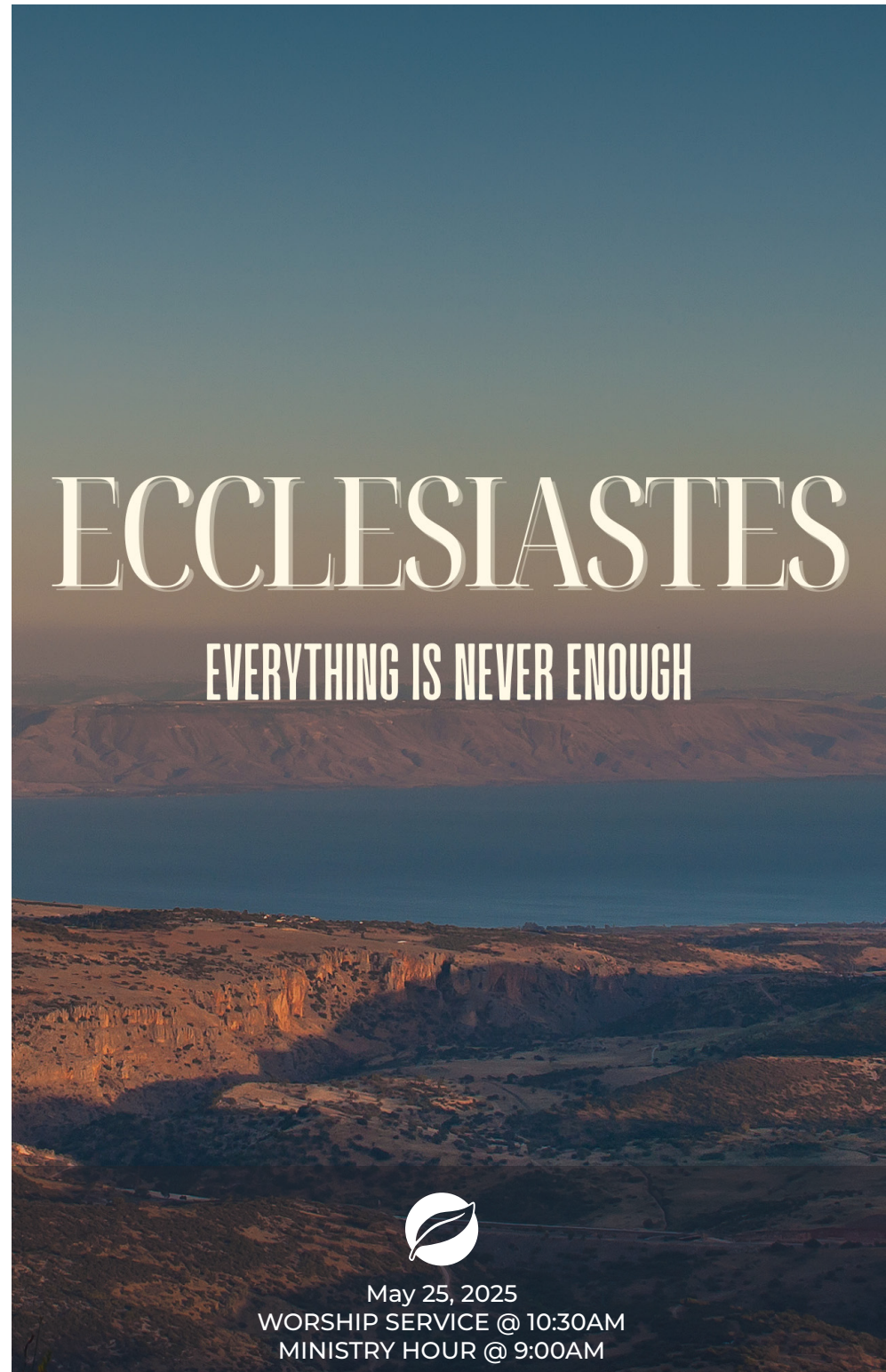
### **Faith Church Office Closed Tomorrow // May 26**

## WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

**Our Elders:** Pray that our elders will have great wisdom as they seek to lead our church through this next season. Pray they would watch their life and doctrine closely and that they would do nothing to disqualify them from their service (1 Tim. 3:1-7; 4:16). Pray they would shepherd the flock not out of compulsion, but willingly; not for shameful gain, but eagerly; not domineering over those in their charge, but being examples to the flock (1 Pet. 5:2-3).

**A Praying Church:** Ask that we will always pray and not lose heart (Luke 18:1). Ask that we may see what a tremendous privilege it is that we are invited and encouraged to draw near to God in prayer (James 4:8). Ask that by God's grace we will daily bring our praises, confessions, petitions, thanksgivings, and intercessions. Ask that as a church, we will devote ourselves to praying together more (Acts 1:14). Pray that the Spirit will help us in our weaknesses and teach us how to pray (Rom. 8:26).

**FOCUS Ministry in the UAE:** Pray for our supported workers Nisin and Joanna Matthew and Tobin and Binita Mattacal as they work in this ministry. They recently held a spring conference with students from many different backgrounds attending. Pray that the Word would do the work in those students hearts. Pray that the churches in the UAE would be strengthened and the love of Christ would flourish.

**Our Governing Authorities:** Pray for our governing authorities in light of our memorializing those who have sacrificed their lives in service to our country. Pray for our country to be a place that rewards goodness and dissuades wickedness (Rom. 13:3). Pray for us to have freedom to follow the Lord with a clear conscience. Pray for effective governmental leadership, "so that we may lead a tranquil and quiet life in all godliness and dignity." (1 Tim. 2:1-4).

**Our Wisdom:** Pray that we will grow as a church in wisdom. May we live well under the sun (Ecc. 1:3). May we live in-light of death and in light of eternity (Ecc. 1:2). May we fear God in all things (Ecc. 5:7). Pray that the sermon series through Ecclesiastes has a lasting impact on our collective wisdom.

The mission of Faith Church is to make more and better disciples here and around the world.

## WHY DO WE DO THAT?

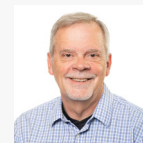
### Gospel Liturgy

"Liturgy" literally means "the work of the people" or "public" (leito) "works" (ergos). Author Bryan Chapell defines it as the public way a church honors God in its times of gathered praise, prayer, instruction, and commitment. It's the work of the people to give praise and honor that God is due. We use "gospel liturgy" to mean that its parts work together to disciple people in the movements of the gospel: God; Man; Christ; Response. These four elements shape our worship services, which we want to humble us and exalt the grace of God that is in Christ Jesus. Our hope each week is for people to be formed and re-formed by the gospel of Jesus Christ.
