WAYS TO PRAY THIS WEEK:

Our Wisdom: As we wrap up our sermon series in Ecclesiastes, pray once again that we will grow in wisdom as a church. Pray that we live well under the sun (Ecclesiastes 1:3) and that we will fear God and keep his commands (Ecclesiastes 12:13) all the days of our brief existence on this earth.

Unity in Diversity: Pray for our church to continue on in a spirit of love and unity (Romans 12:3-8). May we grow in diversity across many different cultural dividing lines. Pray that the unifying power of the gospel would be the thing that binds us together especially as we go through this time of transition in our church (John 17:20-26).

Our Children & Youth: Thank God for the children and youth of our church! Pray we would see them as a gift from the Lord and an integral part of our church family. Pray that our children will come to Jesus and enter his kingdom (Matthew 10:13-16). Pray their parents would be faithful to raise them in the fear and instruction of the Lord (Ephesians 6:4). Pray for protection against the schemes of the devil and the pressures of the world that are especially challenging to our youth (Ephesians 6:11). Pray that they will flee youthful passions and pursue righteousness, faith, love, and peace (2 Timothy 2:22).

Hope for the Discouraged: Pray for those who are hurting, discouraged, depressed, lonely, and hopeless within our church family. Pray that they would know God's love for them (Ephesians 3:14-19). Pray that they would sense the nearness of God (Psalm 34:18). Pray that they would put their hope and confidence in Christ alone (1 Peter 1:3-6). Pray that our church would wrap our arms around them (Romans 12:10-15).

Fruit from the Preaching of God's Word: Pray that God's Word, as it's preached each week, will do its work of rebuking, correcting, and training in righteousness so that we would be "made complete, equipped for every good work" (2 Timothy 3:16-17). Pray for our pastors, as they labor each week, to preach faithfully, clearly, with great patience, in Christ-exalting ways, and in accordance with sound doctrine (2 Timothy 4:1-3).

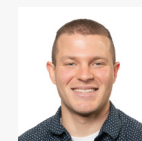

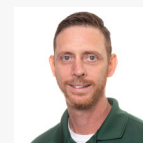
